

## INTERNATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA - GRADE 10 INFORMATION

**Course Scope:**

The International High School Diploma Grade 10 is designed to help students to develop the knowledge of the chosen subjects and the skills to prepare for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) examination. Students who pass at least 1 subject in the examination will be granted an IGCSE certification from Cambridge International Assessment Examinations. Students with good grades from IGCSE examination can look forward to pursuing post-secondary education in Singapore or overseas. Alternatively, upon completion of the International High School Diploma Grade 10, students will be able to progress to International High School Diploma Grade 11.

**Course Duration:** 12-month full-time program with 2 semester per year

*Term 1: January 2nd to June 30th (Other enrollment periods: March or April)*

*Term 2: July 1st to December 31st (Other enrollment periods: September or October)*

*There will be no lessons conducted during the public and school holidays.*

**Lesson Time:** Monday to Friday, 9am to 4pm

**Modules:**

Compulsory Modules: Chinese (0509), Mathematics (0607), Physics (0625), Chemistry (0620), English Language (0500)

Electives Offered: Sciences – Coordinated Double (0654), Additional Mathematics (0606), Biology (0610), Economics (0455), Computer Science (0478), English as a second language (0511)

*\*To apply for International Universities, the applicant(s) must pass at least 3 to 4 subjects*

*\*Elective is only available if 5 or more students choose it*

**Minimum Entry Requirements:**

- Age: 15 years old and above
- Academic Level: Student must have successfully complete Singapore Secondary 3 or equivalent
- Language Proficiency: Obtained a pass in English at Secondary 3 level or equivalent in country of origin, or pass SCI placement test

**Course Assessments:**

- Internal Assessment: Placement tests, monthly assessment, end of term examinations, and class participation.
- External Assessment: Cambridge IGCSE Examinations (Log in to <http://www.cie.org.uk/> for more information)

**Course Completion:**

- International students' (Student's Pass holders) attendance must not be less than 90% and not be absent for more than 7 days in a row.
- After the students have completed and passed the International High School – Grade 10 examination, they will be awarded with the International High School – Grade 10 certification

**Information to be provided by the applicant :**

1. One copy of the duly completed student enrollment application form
2. Photocopy of student's passport (First page)
3. One passport-sized photographs of the student (white background)
4. Parents' passport photocopy (first page) / parents' NRIC photocopy
5. The following notarized documents are to be prepared in advanced in English (After the approval of student's pass, relevant information will have to be provided according to ICA's requirements):
  - Notarized copy of the student's Birth Certificate
  - Notarized copy of the student's highest educational certificates (students who are currently studying may request the school to produce a verification letter before the notarization)
  - Notarized copy of the student's transcripts (students who are currently studying may request the school to produce a verification letter before the notarization)
  - Notarized copy of the student's or his/her parents' bank account (saving period must be above 3 months, and above one hundred and fifty thousand RMB dollars inside the account) – only applicable to students holding China passport

**Applicants should know :**

1. The application fee of \$540 or \$216 are non-refundable and non-transferable.
2. After paying for the application fee, the school will verify if the student fulfills the admission requirements. Next, the letter of offer will be issued and the students are required to pay for the outstanding fees.
3. ICA will request for an Issuance Fee of \$60 - \$90 upon the approval of student pass.
4. Students might be required by ICA to go for medical check-up, at a fee of \$40 - \$60, this fee is not included in the above fees.
5. Students have to sign the student contract and make full payment of all fees one month before the commencement of the course.
6. Local students (Singaporean & PR) and international students who do not need to apply for a student's pass, and have already possessed their own medical insurance, have an option not to purchase medical insurance from the school, but are required to submit the purchased insurance documents to the school.
7. The minimum age requirement of IGCSE Examination is 15 years old as at 1st January of the examination year. Additional payment for examination fee will be charged.
8. Payment method: Cheque/Telegraphic Transfer(TT)/NETS/Cash. For every remittance, an extra \$30 must be added for the bank processing fee.
