DIPLOMA IN HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT (PART-TIME)

Objectives

To provide students with a managerial orientation towards tourism and hospitality management and appreciation of the mechanism of the industry. Students will learn the management and organization involved in the provision and consumption of hospitality and tourism products and services. This course is designed to prepare students for supervisory and management level responsibilities in the hospitality and tourism sector and equip them with an integrated knowledge of management principles and the operations of the industry. Graduates of this course can proceed to our Advanced Diploma in Hospitality and Tourism Management course.

Duration

- **9 months (Part time course)**, 6 hours per week.

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Pre-requisites

Age: 16 years old and above

Academic Level: At least 10 years of formal education or equivalent; OR Pass in SCI's placement test; OR have at least one year of relevant working experience.

Language Proficiency: English Language with IELTS 5.5 and above; OR GCE O-Level grade C6 and better; OR pass SCI's language proficiency test or equivalent.

Mode of Assessment

Internal Assessment: 10% class participation, 40% written assignments and test, 50% written examinations and passed the industrial attachment

Course Completion

- Local students (Singaporean & PR) and students with Dependent Pass - at least **75%** attendance.
- Upon completion of all 9 modules and industrial attachment/project work, tStudents who fulfilled the required attendance, attain at least a marginal pass in each module, earn full module credits, and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 will be awarded the **Diploma in Hospitality and Tourism Management** by Spring College International.
